Each student athlete will be required to take the ACT or SAT College entrance exams. Should students fall behind or fail to complete school assignments, they will not be able to participate in baseball activities until school work is caught up or consequences have been met for incomplete assignments. School holds priority over baseball."

# **Badlands Academy Baseball Student Athlete Code of Conduct**
