Practice and fall game schedule

Fall practice will start one-half hour after school every school day except Mondays which will be a day off. You can plan on having games scheduled almost every weekend in the fall. The spring schedule will be very similar to the fall schedule.

Fundraising

Each student will be responsible for 1500\$ worth of fundraising. This will take place through both raffle tickets as well as a hockey pool. Players and/or families will be able to sell raffle or hockey pool entries to earn their money back. Families may keep all monies earned up to and beyond the 1500\$. Players and/or families may choose to not participate in selling raffles or entries after their 1500\$ payment if they so choose. Each family will be responsible for the 1500\$ through either an individual payment at the beginning of the season, or have the amount added on and divided up in their payment plans.

Each student athlete will be expected to participate in the Programs fundraisers. They must attend and help with the Annual Baseball at Dusk banquet and all other fundraising projects. The academy greatly depends on reaching our annual fundraising goals in order to keep tuition costs down as well as to provide the terrific experience that our players and families expect.

Academics

Academics are the single most important part of our program. Each student athlete must understand the primary reason for them being in the Badlands Baseball Academy is to achieve the best possible education they can at South Central High School. If a student athlete intends on moving onto a University to compete in their baseball program, grade point level will directly influence the number of potential Universities or Colleges they will be able to move onto upon graduation from South Central High School. Each student athlete will be required to take the ACT or SAT College entrance exams. Should students fall behind or fail to complete school assignments, they will not be able to participate in baseball activities until school work is caught up or consequences have been met for incomplete assignments. School holds priority over baseball. "

Badlands Academy Baseball Student Athlete Code of Conduct

We expect our student athletes to be model citizens while in school and in the community. You cannot forget that Badlands Baseball Academy Student Athletes and Coaches will be recognized throughout the community. We expect everyone involved with our program to remember that every action displayed in public, billets homes or at school will be labeled as Badlands Baseball Academy actions. Therefore our Student Athletes must be polite and considerate whenever they are dealing with the public, billets or school personnel. Student Athletes are expected to get along with both their billet families and teammates, and treat them with nothing but respect. It is also mandatory that all Student Athletes treat any and all billets homes, baseball facilities, and baseball equipment and uniforms with the utmost respect, keeping them clean and well groomed with no damage. During their time at the Badlands Baseball Academy, it will be mandatory for each Student Athlete to be involved in the Community when needed and to be part of all fundraisers the Academy organizes. The Student Athlete's main priority will be to keep up and maintain their school grades, along with having a steady attendance both at school and baseball practices and events. The Student Athlete must also be on time to class and practice. No Student Athlete will be allowed in Bars, Lounges or any alcohol distributing locations. You are not to be associated with illegal alcohol or substance abuse in any way shape or form. Tobacco and drugs of any description is not permitted at all. You are not here to party, you are here to get an **education** and play baseball. If the student athlete fails to comply with the code of conduct provided by the Academy, the Academy has the right to remove the student athlete at their discretion.

Permission of Consent

The Badlands Baseball Academy has the right to perform college style random drug tests on any of their student athletes. The Academy also has the permission to contact previous schools attended by the student athlete.
